

Business Technology Management Program Update



Please be advised that the Business Technology Management (BTM) program will gradually transition to North Seattle College. The date for the transition has not yet been determined, but it will most likely be Spring 2026, Summer 2026, or Fall 2026. Currently, classes are still being offered at Seattle Central College, and they will likely continue to be offered at Central until the transition has been completed. Depending on when you begin the BTM program, you may need to take classes at both Central and North, and you may eventually complete your degree or certificate at North.

When a date for the transition has been finalized, students who are already taking classes will be informed by the program and/or their international student advisor. Students who have been admitted but have not yet started classes will be informed of the transition date by International Admissions.

Students who plan to enroll in the BTM program and have not yet made a decision about housing may want to consider a housing option with the program move in mind. Central and North are not far from one another. It only takes about 15 minutes to drive from Central to North and about 13 minutes to travel by Light Rail (subway), and there are plenty of housing options in the area between the two campuses.
