The I-20 form will list the same financial requirements as posted on our webpage for 9 months, but in a slightly different format:

*Tuition and fees include the following:

Intensive English – Tuition: \$9,450; Approximate fees: \$221
College Bridge & College Programs – Tuition: \$9,948; Approximate fees: \$555
B.A.S. Degree Programs – Tuition: \$19,302; Approximate fees: \$555

Program fees for some Career Training programs range from \$357 - \$6,527, and are not included in the amounts above. These additional fees will be added to the I-20 form if students are accepted to one of these Career Training programs.

**Living expenses include average room and board costs.

***Other expenses include books, supplies, transportation (bus pass), and medical insurance.

Students who applied for a college-level program and will to test on arrival will receive an I-20 form with a college program estimate.
