

How To Send Test Scores

General guidelines

- Unofficial score reports are accepted. All scores submitted are verified with test providers.
- Admitted students who have updated scores may submit them up to two weeks before the start of the quarter.
- Students who work with educational advising agencies should submit their test results through their agency.

TOEFL (test scores valid for 2 years)

Score reports can be uploaded to the online admission portal. Uploads must be a copy of the actual score report. International Admissions cannot accept screen shots of online core information.

IELTS (test scores valid for 2 years)

Score reports can be uploaded to the online admission portal. Uploads must be a copy of the actual score report. International Admissions cannot accept screen shots of online core information.

Duolingo (test scores valid for 2 years)

Official DET score reports can be uploaded in the online admission portal. International Admissions will attempt to verify your DET using the secure certificate link on the report. Please be sure to make your certificate public. Information on how to do this is available here: <https://testcenter.zendesk.com/hc/en-us/articles/10866896236813-Certificate-privacy-settings> .

If International Admissions is unable to verify your DET using the certificate link, then you will be asked to send your test results directly to Seattle Colleges from your Duolingo account. To send your test results, follow the steps below:

- log into your Duolingo account then scroll down to your certified test results and click “Share Score”
- When prompted for the name of your institution, type “Seattle Colleges”
- If you have one, enter your application reference or EMPLID number
- Press “Send Scores”
