

Other English Proficiency

Students with the following test scores can be admitted directly into the corresponding College Bridge level:

College Bridge Level 4

- Canadian Academic English Language (CAEL): 40 or higher
- Global Test of English Communication (GTEC): 1040
- International Test of English Proficiency (iTEP) Academic Plus: 4.5 or higher
- Michigan English Language Assessment Battery (MELAB): 75 or higher
- Pearson Test of English (PTE): 41
- TOEFL PBT*: 470, writing 3
- TOEFL Institutional**: 470, no writing
- Completion of one year of study at a U.S. high school, or at a high school where English is the medium of instruction, taking no ESL classes. Transcripts must show a B or 3.0 GPA, or placement in the top 20% of the class. If study occurred in countries where English is not the official language, proof that English was the medium of instruction may be required.
- Completion of one year of study at an accredited post-secondary institution in Australia, Canada (English-speaking provinces), Ireland, Kenya, New Zealand, United Kingdom, United States, or Zimbabwe, without completion of English Composition.

College Bridge Level 5

- Cambridge First Certificate (FCE): Grade B or C
- Global Test of English Communication (GTEC): 1055
- Pearson Test of English (PTE): 43
- Swedish Upper Secondary School Leaving Certificate (Avgångsbetyg / Slutbetyg från Gymnasieskola): Grade of 15 or higher in English
- TOEFL PBT*: 483, writing 4
- TOEFL Institutional**: 483, no writing

College Bridge Level 6

- Cambridge Advanced Certificate (CAE): Grade C or higher (passing)
- Cambridge First Certificate (FCE): Grade A
- Global Test of English Communication (GTEC): 1075
- Pearson Test of English (PTE): 44
- TOEFL PBT*: 498, writing 5
- TOEFL Institutional**: 498, no writing
