When you apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth – even before you leave your home country!

HERE'S HOW EASY IT IS!

- 1 Apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, indicating your transfer preference to University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth on your application.
- 2 Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Colleges, and a conditional letter of admission from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth at the same time.
- 3 Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4 Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an Associate degree.
- 5 Transfer to University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6 Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth!

TRANSFER ADMISSION LETTER FOR UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA RIVERSIDE:

- 1 Complete an approved transferable associate degree at Seattle Colleges.
- 2 Earn a minimum 2.5 cumulative gpa on transferable credits from all previous institutions. Note that Biology, Chemistry, Engineering, and Medical Laboratory Science majors require a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.7. Students with a cumulative gpa of 3.25 or higher qualify to receive a merit scholarship; for more details, visit www.umassd.edu/financialaid/scholarships/admissions/.
- 3 Submit proof of English proficiency. English proficiency can be met through submitting test scores (pBT 520 / iBT 68 / IELTS 6) or by completing both English 101 and 102 with a grade of C or higher.
- 4 Submit an international application with official copies of all transcripts at www.umassd.edu/apply/.
- 5 Adhere to the University of Massachusetts, Dartmouth's deadlines for application and document submission, and admission policies.
- 6 Upon full admission, submit all required documents for F-1 student status and SEVIS transfer.
