When you apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, you may also request and receive a Transfer Admission Guarantee from Western Washington University – even before you leave your home country!

HERE'S HOW EASY IT IS!

- 1 Apply for admission to Seattle Colleges, indicating your transfer preference to Western Washington University on your application.
- 2 Receive your acceptance letter from Seattle Colleges, and a conditional letter of admission from Western Washington University at the same time.
- 3 Interview at the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4 Complete the first two years of your Bachelor's degree at Seattle Colleges by getting an Associate degree.
- 5 Transfer to Western Washington University to complete the last two years of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6 Graduate and receive your Bachelor's degree from Western Washington University!

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS FOR WESTERN WASHINGTON UNIVERSITY:

- 1 Complete an approved transferable associate degree at Seattle Colleges (Associate of Arts, Associate of Science – Transfer or MRP transfer degrees).
- 2 Submit transcripts from all previous post-secondary institutions attended. If you earned credit in a country other than the U.S. or Canada, an official transcript evaluation from a NACES member institution may also be requested by the Admissions Committee (www.naces.org/members.htm).
- 3 Earn a minimum 3.00 cumulative grade point average on transferable credit from all previous institutions attended.
- 4 Meet WWU's English Proficiency requirements by completing English Composition I (ENGL& 101) and English Composition II (ENGL& 102) with a 3.0 GPA. Or submit an official TOEFL iBT score of 80 or IELTS score of 6.5 or above.
- 5 Submit an International Undergraduate Application for Admission by the application deadline for the term of application (admissions.wvu.edu/apply).
- 6 Submit a signed Statement of Financial Responsibility and official bank statement.

Please note that while many academic majors are open to all interested students, others are competitive, requiring a separate admissions application, prerequisite coursework and/or an elevated grade point average. Please note that admission to Western Washington University does not guarantee admission to a specific academic program.
